BROAD SPECTRUM ANTIBACTERIAL

Composition

Each bolus contains:

Sulphadimidine IP 5000 mg
Excipients q.s.

Description:

Sulphadimidine is a chemotherapeutic with bacteriostatic action against many Gram-positive and Gram-negative bacteria and against certain protozoa like Eimeria and Isospora species. Sulphadimidine is used for oral treatment of gastrointestinal infections, respiratory infections, Fowl Cholera and Coccidiosis in poultry, turkey and rabbits.

Indications and Usage:

Veterinary Sulphadimidine Bolus is highly effective against a wide range of bacterial, protozoal and certain rickettsial organisms. It is particularly used in cases of Septicemia, Pneumonia, and diseases caused by Salmonella, Pasteurella and coliform organisms. Sulphadimidine is used for oral treatment of gastrointestinal infections, respiratory infections, Fowl Cholera and Coccidiosis in poultry, turkey and rabbits.

Dosage

Large animals : 2 bolus/50kg/bwt
followed by half the dose for 3-5 days.

Small animals: 1 bolus/25kg/bwt for 3-5 days.
Intra-uterine 1 bolus insert deep into the
uterus or as directed by the veterinarian only.

Storage:

Store in a cool & dry place, Protected from light

Withdrawal period:

For Meat 21 days

For Milk 5 days
